## **Bar Report – 2020-06-22 - AGM**

The 2019/2020 season was a big change for the WLCC lounge as we went to a volunteer management and bartending system after Laura Ball's departure. It was a learning curve for us all as we developed new policies, trained servers and ensured everyone had their Serve it Right Course. We had thirteen people who worked the bar on a volunteer basis during regular league play and the new drop-in Saturday nights. Many others helped out during the various parties and bonspiels. Thanks to everyone for your hard work and dedication!

From late November until Christmas we hosted a birthday party and four private Christmas parties. The parties were all successful, however, we did learn that running them too late makes it difficult for the volunteers, so we will be amending some of the end times to relieve the pressure. We hired one additional person for parties and bonspiels and this worked well.

Our bar income was up 3.1% (\$33,497 vs \$32,486) from 2019 and our labor expense for the bar was minimal due to the volunteers.

We plan to run the lounge on a volunteer basis again for the 2020/2021 season and I encourage other club members to take the Serve it Right course and help out at the bar whenever you can.
