Return to Curling Policy

Coming off the Ice:

- At the finish of play, congratulate the other team members and teammates by tapping brooms while keeping a 2m distance.
- Sanitize your hands.
- Prior to go to the common area through the glass doors, **please mask up**.
- Sanitize any club equipment (brooms, crutches, sliders, grippers) and put away.
- Gather any personal items from the bleachers, maintaining physical distancing as much as possible, with your mask on.
- Follow the markers on the floor in the common area. You now have a choice:
 - If you are heading straight up to the lounge (if open) follow the arrows on the floor and stay to the right side of the stairway, while physically distancing.
 - Masks may be removed once seated in a physically distanced way.
 - If you are going to the locker room first, and then to the lounge, (mask on):
 - check the locker room for members as only 5 are allowed in either of the rooms at any given time.
 - deposit your curling items (jackets, shoes, gloves, and broom) into your locker, while physical distancing.
 - proceed to the lounge following the markers on the floor and stairs.
 - If you are leaving the club immediately you must keep your mask on and:
 - check the locker room for members as only 5 are allowed in either of the rooms at any given time. Deposit your curling items (jackets, shoes, gloves, and broom) into your locker (while physical distancing).
 - place your outdoor shoes on by the exit. Only 4 members allowed in the boot room at any given time. May remove your mask once outside.
- If you are in the lounge and have placed your order at the bar, please find a table for you and your team – ensure you are physically distancing, remove your mask, and enjoy your drink.
- When leaving the lounge please put on your mask and follow all procedures above for using the locker room and exit (boot) room. Masks may be removed once outside.
