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Williams Lake Curling Club Outbreak Policy

The Williams Lake Curling Club with guidance from Curl BC, Viasport BC, Worksafe BC and the PHO of BC will be operating the facility with the following **Outbreak Policy** to ensure the safety of its members by minimizing possible exposures to suspect, probable and confirmed cases of Covid-19 and to prevent further spread of the virus when an outbreak has been declared.

An “**outbreak**” as defined by the BC CDC is two or more cases of Covid-19 diagnosed within a 14-day period in a common or closed location, with evidence of transmission occurring within the facility

A “**case**” is a single case of Covid-19.

The **manager/delegate** is a person of authority at the WLCC which may be either the current manager or a person delegated by the WLCC Board of Directors.

1. If WLCC is notified of an “**outbreak**” or “**case**” by Public Health, the **manager/delegate** shall...
 - work with **Public Health** to implement guidelines and provide the necessary contact tracing documents as applicable
 - implement the **WLCC Illness Policy** and advise individuals to...
 - monitor their symptoms daily, and to use the BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool to help determine if further assessment or testing for COVID-19 is needed.
 - contact 8-1-1 if further health advice is required and 9-1-1 if it is an emergency.
 - leave the facility if they develop Covid-19 symptoms while at the facility
 - advise those **members/others** that may have been exposed that **Public Health will contact only those individuals who have had direct contact with the confirmed case.**
 - ensure that all **members/others** who enter the club practice diligent hand hygiene, maintain physical distance, and wear a face mask where mandated.
 - implement enhanced cleaning measures to reduce risk of transmission.

2. If WLCC is notified of a **probable** or **confirmed “case”** by an individual the **manager/delegate** shall...
- notify **Public Health** and follow their guidelines
 - alert the general membership of a possible exposure while maintaining confidentiality
 - implement the **WLCC Illness Policy** and advise individuals to...
 - monitor their symptoms daily, and to use the BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool to help determine if further assessment or testing for COVID-19 is needed.
 - contact 8-1-1 if further health advice is required and 9-1-1 if it is an emergency.
 - **stay home if feeling sick**
 - leave the facility if they develop Covid-19 symptoms while at the facility
 - ensure that all members/others who enter the club practice diligent hand hygiene, maintain physical distance, and wear a face mask where mandated.
 - Implement enhanced cleaning measures to reduce risk of transmission
