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Williams Lake Curling Club Illness Policy

The Williams Lake Curling Club, with guidance from Curl BC, Viasport BC, Worksafe BC and the PHO of BC, will be operating the facility with the following **illness policy** to ensure the safety of its members and to stop the spread of Covid -19 or other communicable diseases. In this policy, “**Member**” includes an employee, volunteer, participant, or parent/spectator. In this policy “**Others**” include contractors, kitchen staff, tenants, sponsors, vendors, lounge guests and other people who enter the facility.

1. **WLCC** will communicate to **Members** and **Others** that they should remain at home if they are feeling sick.
 - a. Advise them to contact Health Link BC at 8-1-1.
2. **WLCC** will communicate to **Members** and **Others** that they should remain at home if someone in their household is showing symptoms of Covid-19 or other illness.
3. **WLCC** will ensure that **Members** and **Others** who enter the facility are not feeling sick or showing symptoms of a communicable disease.
 - a. **Members** and **Others** will perform a self-assessment by reviewing signage of Covid-19 symptoms upon entering the facility
 - b. If they have symptoms, they will be required to leave the facility.
 - c. If they are unsure, advise them to use the BC Covid-19 self-assessment tool that will be located on the Public Health website.
4. **WLCC** will ensure that **Members** and **Others** who develop symptoms while at the facility will be sent home immediately and asked to monitor their symptoms for a 24-hour period. If the symptoms persist have them contact 8-1-1 or a physician for guidance.
5. **WLCC** will follow the guidance of the Local Health Authority if a **Member** or **Others** tests positive for **COVID-19**.
 - a. Cleaning and disinfecting will be performed of possible contaminated areas.
6. **WLCC** will communicate to **Members** and **Others** that they should follow the guidance of the Local Health Authority if they have been tested and are waiting for results of a **Covid-19 test**.
 - a. The **Member** or **Other** shall not be allowed in the facility until they are cleared to do so by the Local Health Authority or Physician.
7. Any **Member** or **Other** who may have been in contact with a **COVID-19 positive** person or suspected positive person shall not be allowed in the facility and must follow the advice of the Local Health Authority. They may return to the facility when told it is safe to do so by the PHA.
